Financial aid and merit scholarships range from partial tuition to smaller awards covering only the application fee. Award amounts are determined on a sliding scale based on financial need, while merit awards are determined competitively. All decisions are final. A limited number of merit scholarships will be granted—applicants should note that all CBK applicants are highly successful.

## Notification

Once the Committee has made a determination, the candidate will be notified by May 14th as to the amount of the award, if any. This notification will be made both by phone and formal letter and prior to the final payment deadline of May 21st for Summer Programs. If the decision affects the student's ability to attend the program, please notify CBK immediately so that a waitlisted student may take the candidate's place. Awards will be applied directly against total payment for the program. No monetary funds will be distributed to families. Please do not call CBK to check on your award status—contacts will be made as quickly as possible.

## Required Documentation for Merit Scholarship

- CBK Summer Programs Application
- Merit Portfolio—for awards greater than \$100; Merit Essay also required (see below)  
 The portfolio should be no larger than 8.5"x11" and contain no more than 10 pages, contained in a folder. These materials will not be returned and do not have to directly relate to chosen Summer Programs course content. The portfolio should demonstrate scholarliness, creativity, leadership, community service, and/or originality.
- Merit Essay—for awards \$100 or less  
 In addition to application essay, this essay of no more than 250 words should address what makes the candidate stand out in a group of high-interest or high-ability peers. Please note that all CBK applicants are highly qualified.
- Merit Letter of Recommendation (In addition to 2 required for application—no more than 2 merit letters, please)
