B. **This statement must be read carefully, signed and dated by the applicant’s parent and/or legal guardian:** I hereby allow my child to participate in CBK Summer Programs. I have read the catalogue carefully and I realize that while CBK can help my child with his/her future education, it cannot be responsible for direct articulation with his/her school. I will be responsible for arrangements with the school to award credit to my child if he/she would like to attempt to receive credit.

I have enclosed an application fee of \$50 that I understand is not refundable under **any** circumstances, and a deposit for 50% of program tuition payable to CNDC CBK. Tuition deposits will be refunded only if my child is not accepted into CBK Summer Programs, we do not receive a sufficient financial aid award to attend, all course choices are cancelled, or we withdraw in writing prior to May 25th at 4pm MST (incurring a 9% fee). I understand that full payment is due no later than **May 21st**, or the program acceptance process will be discontinued. I also understand that in the event of my child’s hospitalization or the death of a parent, guardian, or sibling during the program, up to 50% of prorated tuition will be refunded less a 9% fee. I understand that if I choose to withdraw my child at any time after **May 25th, 4pm MST**, there will be no refund of any monies paid. I understand the Student Conduct policies and if my child is dismissed from the program for violation of the CBK Summer Programs Honor Code or campus policy, I understand that I will receive no refund. I will also take responsibility for all costs associated with my child’s immediate return home within 12 hours of a dismissal call from the Executive Director.
